Our school wide expectations are represented by the word *ROAR* which stands for: *R-responsible, O-organized, A-always safe, and R-respectful*. As a child's first "teacher", parents and guardians teach children how to be responsible by attending school every day and arriving on time. As stated on page 6 of the "STPSB 2015-16 Handbook for Students and Parents" that was sent home with all students, "*School attendance is imperative, not only to satisfy requirements of the law but to help ensure student achievement and success. Every missed day of school is a missed opportunity to learn.*" Our school day begins at 8:35 am and ends at 3:31 pm. Attendance and punctuality are positive work habits that contribute to being successful in any future profession or job!

In an effort to raise awareness about the importance of attendance to all students and parents, the PBIS committee at Lyon recognizes students on a monthly basis that have earned PERFECT ATTENDANCE. In order for a student to earn "Perfect Attendance", they must be at school every day from 8:35 am until 3:31 pm. If a student is tardy OR gets checked out early, they will NOT be eligible for perfect attendance. There will be no exceptions. We will recognize students in the cafeteria during lunch, by calling out their names and giving them some type of "award".

Thank you for continuing to work with us in teaching our students one way of being responsible is by attending school on time, all day, every day.
